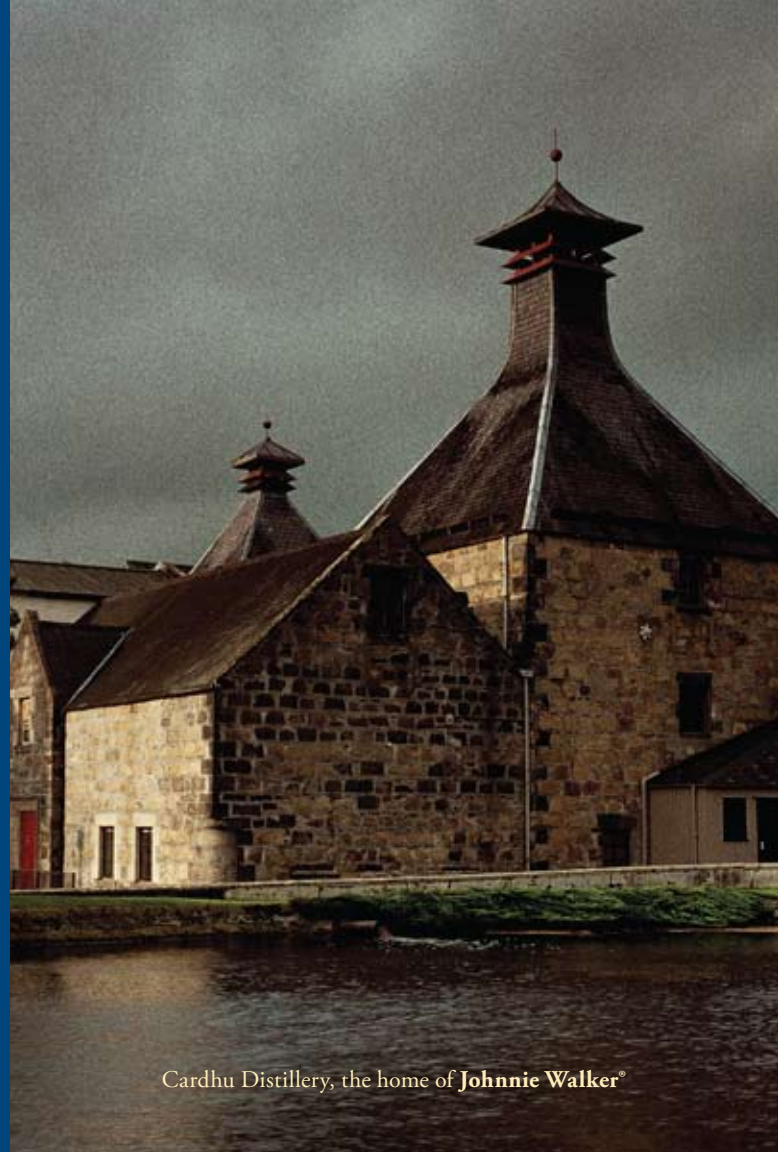
True to its heritage, this exquisite blend is handcrafted using the original techniques practiced during the era. Only whiskies from distilleries existing in the reign of King George V have been used.
